## AFTERCARE

Notes: Students not picked up by 6:00 pm will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per minute. This charge will be applied per family, not per child.

## POLICIES

### WHAT YOU AND YOUR FAMILY NEED TO KNOW

1. Facts will assess an additional \$30.00 late fee each time funds are not available for payment.
2. Delinquent accounts will result in the following:
  - a. Students will not be permitted to start school in the fall unless their account is up to date.
  - b. Students will not be permitted to attend school if after the second attempt by Facts the funds are still unavailable. If the student has been removed from class as a result of delinquent tuition, the account must be paid up to date in order for the student to be re-enrolled.
  - c. Any senior whose account is not paid in full prior to graduation will not receive his/her diploma or final transcript until all monies have been paid.
  - d. Report cards and transcripts will be withheld if a family leaves the school still owing tuition or any other fee. All checks must have cleared the school's account before grades, transcripts or diplomas, etc. are released.
  - e. If an account is not paid in full by the 8th of June, TCA may place the family on a waiting list if classes are at or near capacity.
3. If a student(s) withdraws after the July 8th payment but prior to the August 8th payment the July payment is non-refundable. If a student(s) withdraws after the August 8th payment the July and August payments are non-refundable.
4. If a registered student withdraws from school for any reason during the school year, they are responsible for tuition through the full month of withdrawal date.
5. All student withdrawals will be assessed a fee of \$100.00.
6. TCA will pursue outstanding balances for all unpaid tuition accounts.
7. We expect that our families will set Christian education as a financial priority.
